5	Hill of Fare Wind Farm Update – Frank Murray gave update as follows – The methods of assessing wind farms turbine noise (ETSU-R-97 standards) published in 1996 is out dated and very limited - it also does not comply with EU Law or with the UK Regulations on Environmental Assessments as outlined in an "alternative view" paper written by Dick Bowdler. M.S.P. A Burnett has asked questions linked to the standards and the Scottish Government have asked for an update on the position. Local contractors are visiting and viewing the site along with the main Project Manager. Challenges made on wrong information being communicated to general public linked to the words used "tallest windfarm" as opposed to "largest windfarm" which we are noting.
