## 3 Deputy Chairman report for year with thanks –

It has been a busy year for our group representing our Community in some fairly lengthy and involved subjects which I have summarised as follows -:

Storm Arwen follow up public meeting Monymusk with John Swinney then Keith Brown & Council resilience team in attendance "supporting our Communities better" resilience documents prepared along with questionnaire responses. Lot of work went into this with other spin off areas linked to local groups being established.

SSEN fault management "good will payments" challenges where we supported a big number of Monymusk residents chasing compensation payments - eventually achieved securing a £1400 lump sum that the people involved were happy to donate to the Community Resilience fund.

Cluny School bus was to be withdrawn (August 2022) from Sauchen village to School due to the introduction of the new foot /cycle path being built. A safety risk assessment of the route was pushed for and removal of the bus was delayed to potentially this Aug 2023 as the Council have still some work to be under taken. We need to see the final risk assessment as speed limits and school crossing areas still high risk areas.

Sauchen issues linked to speeding vehicles, potential flooding zones, new housing development challenges associated with road design lay out and retrospective infill soil application(to name a few) were all within our agenda activities.

Monthly planning reviews —in general less applications this year on the domestic side however, the Hill of Fare wind farm & Energy Storage proposal has the potential to significantly impact the Midmar area. To date two Roadshow have been under taken in Midmar Hall (and in other Communities) by RES the renewable energy developer in partnership with Dunecht Estates. Our Community group along with other Community zones have been invited by RES to be present at these information forums .In conjunctions with other Community groups involved a questionnaire was developed to use at the roadshows to help determine local views and concerns. The main local concerns are linked to size of turbines and storage area (largest turbines in Scotland) plus noise and light flicker. In addition to this private water supplies quality and disruption cannot be understated.

The disruption period of the build and establishment of the wind farm will be horrendous for residents in the areas along with the ecology impact.

An updated design document was produced in May 2023 by RES that reduced scale of turbines from 17 to 16 with height of 11 turbines at 180 meters and 5 turbines at 200 meters. The second roadshow outlined the
